

COL(R) Douglas Macgregor



Mission Command in the 21st Century Army

Douglas Macgregor is a decorated combat veteran, the author of five books, a PhD and the executive VP of Burke-Macgregor Group LLC, a defense and foreign policy consulting firm in Reston, VA. He was commissioned in the Regular Army in 1976 after 1 year at VMI and 4 years at West Point. Macgregor retired with the rank of Colonel in 2004. He holds an MA in comparative politics and a PhD in international relations from the University of Virginia.

Macgregor is widely known in military circles inside the U.S., Europe, Israel, China and Korea for both his leadership in the Battle of 73 Easting, the U.S. Army's largest tank battle since World War II, and for his ground breaking books on military transformation: *Breaking the Phalanx* (Praeger, 1997) and *Transformation under Fire* (Praeger, 2003). His fourth book, *Warrior's Rage: The Great Tank Battle of 73 Easting* (Naval Institute Press, 2009) describes the 1991 action for which he was awarded a Bronze Star with "V" device for valor. His books have been translated into Hebrew, Chinese, Russian and Korean. His fifth book, *Margin of Victory*, is currently available from Naval Institute Press.
